I have attached Don Rockwood's (FFGT) latest data. I have worked with this data and the details so I can see trends by individual plants. A production summary is below:

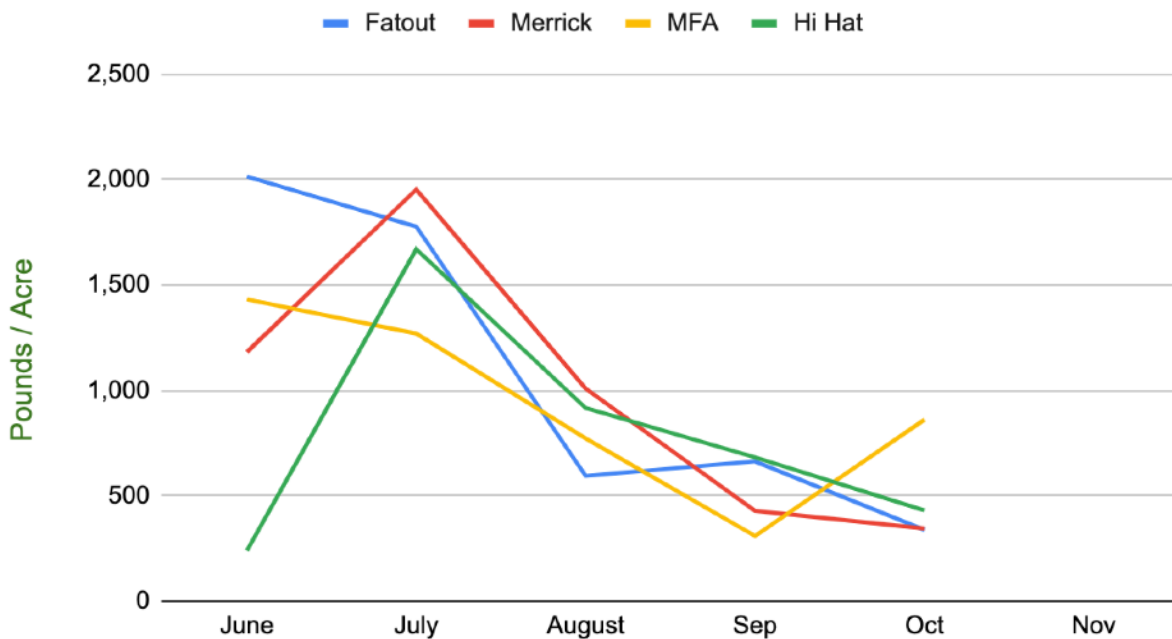
### FBGA Analysis from FFGT and IFAS Key Project Research

The latest month's data was down 5% from the previous month. Within that we had one farm, MFA, which was actually up 178%. You can see on the chart below the drop in production we have experienced over the last several months.

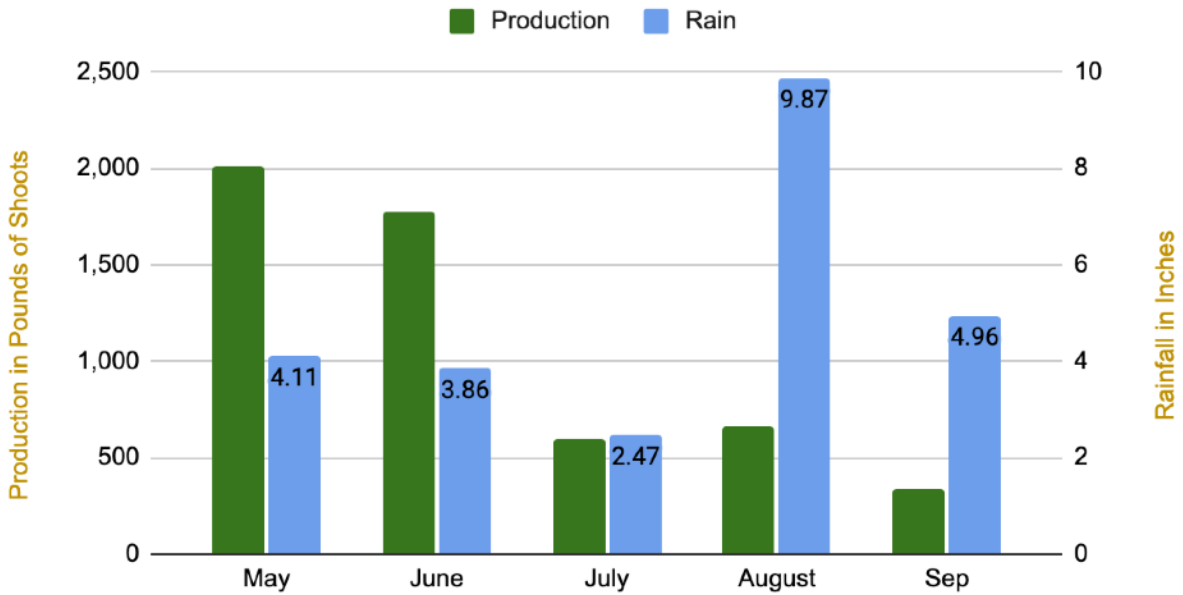
### Shoots Production Pace



I was hopeful that the rainfall in September would have a positive impact on the shoots production but as you can see in the charts following, it really hasn't.

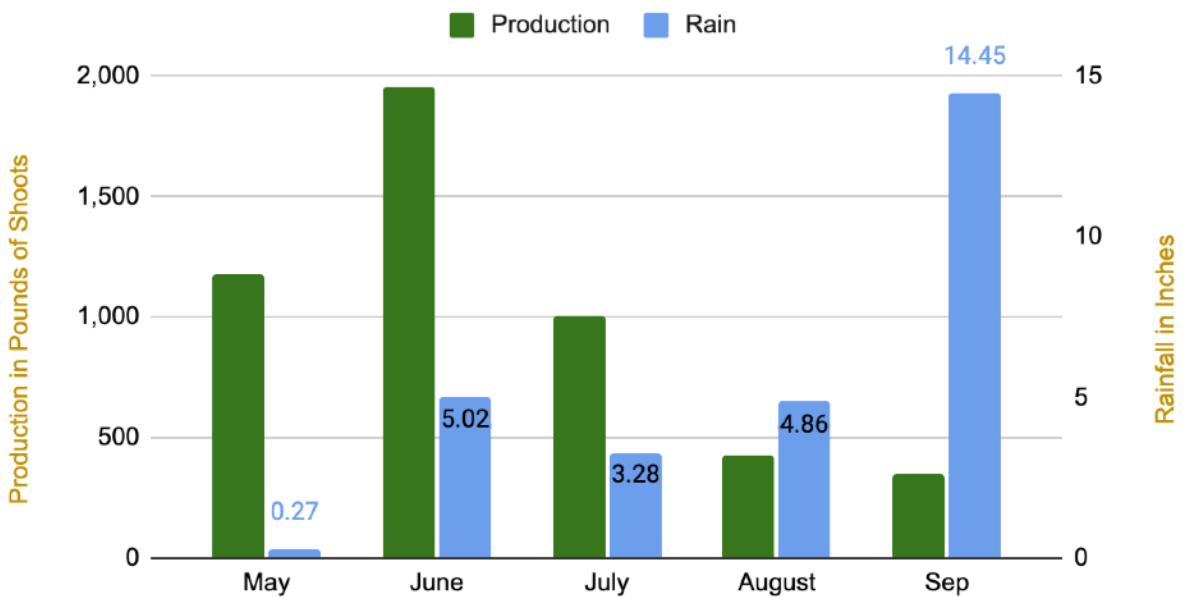
## Fatout Production vs Rainfall

Monthly



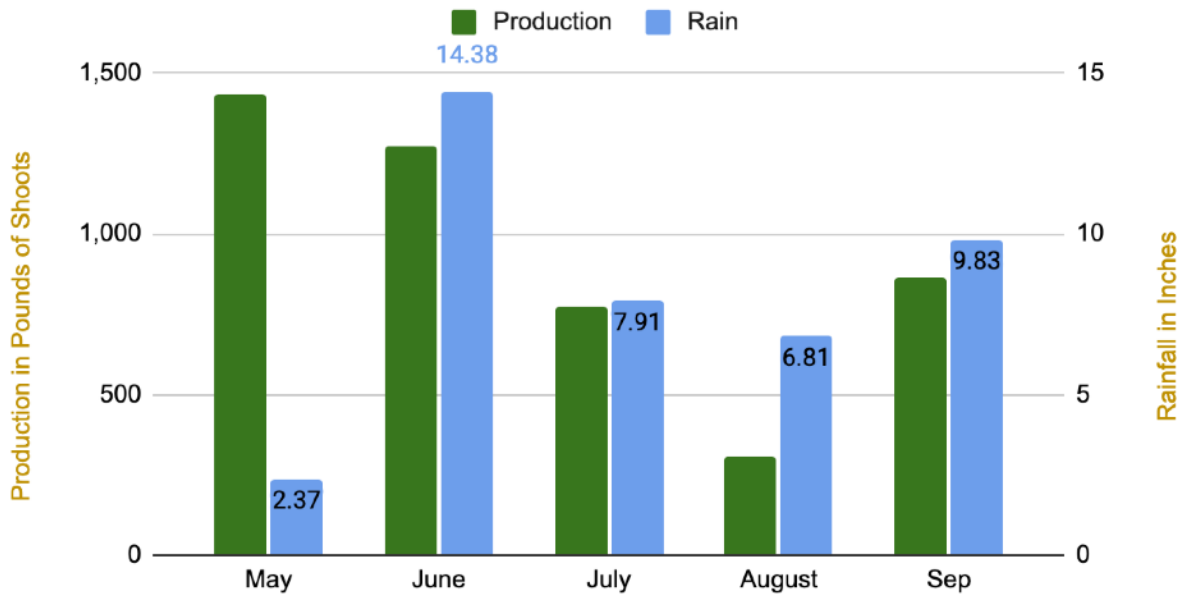
## Merrick Production vs Rainfall

Monthly



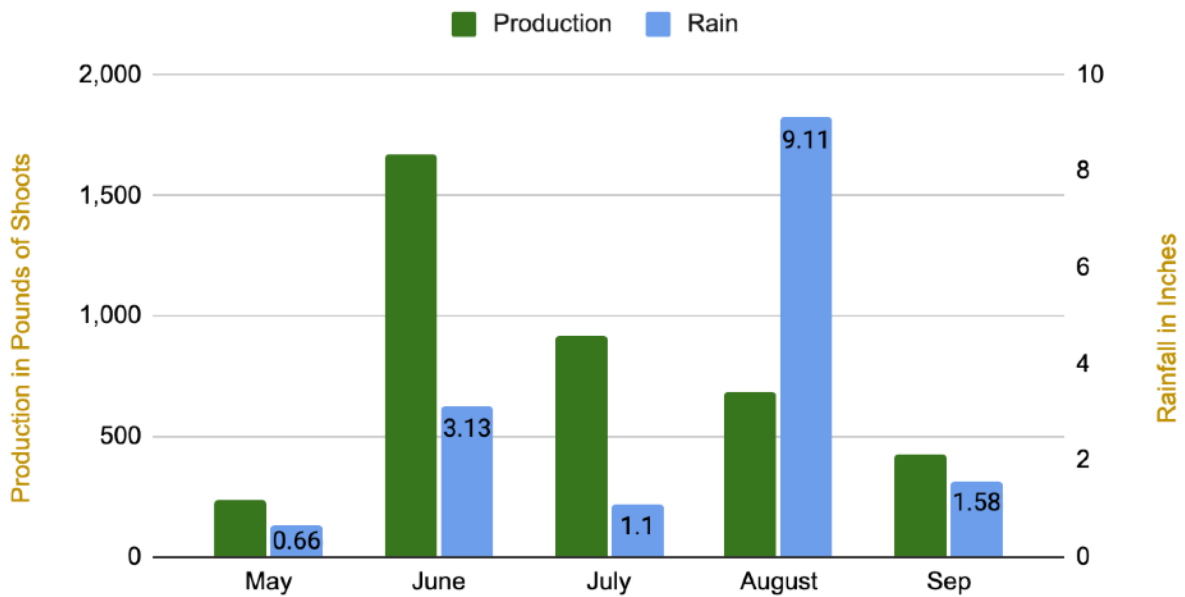
## MFA Production vs Rainfall

Remember that we have one month to go with the season and that will give us a more accurate final count. At the end of the season the new shoots all abort and it is fairly obvious. I thought we were seeing signs of this a week or so ago but then I found the farms producing strongly here in mid October.

Below is a summary showing the quantities and sizes of new shoots by farm. While we have averages of 4-6 new shoots per plant so far, about 20% of the plants produce in much greater quantities as seen in the right hand column.
