As we continue evaluating the impact of February's freeze, we are encouraged by the recovery taking place across Florida bamboo farms. Recent field observations show strong new growth and positive signs that many plants are regenerating as expected.

This spring, we also took an important step forward by developing our first crop forecast using three years of Key Project data. Combined with our ongoing Freeze Recovery research, these efforts will help us better understand production expectations and support future industry growth.

While the 2025 harvest season has been cancelled due to processing limitations outside of growers' control, many believe the additional recovery time may ultimately benefit farm health and strengthen future production. We remain focused on gathering data, learning from this season's challenges, and preparing for a successful future harvest.

We will continue sharing updates as recovery progresses and look forward to the opportunities ahead for Florida's bamboo industry.
